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The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) applies to all children and they are **Rights Holders**. Adults such as parents/carers, teachers and local government are **Duty Bearers** who help children and young people to enjoy their rights.

The steering group



The steering group is a group of young people and adults from across the school community who lead the schools' rights respecting work.

As this group has a leading role to play it is important that the group is representative of

the whole school community. It is also important that the group meets regularly and with clear agendas and action points so that the group can:

- . To take the lead in developing and delivering the school's rights respecting action plan.
- . To ensure that the whole school is aware of the Rights Respecting Schools Award.

- To provide a link between children and young people, teachers, senior management team, governors and the whole school community.
- . To regularly feedback to the school community about progress, including to the SLT, governors, staff and parents.
- To prepare for the assessment by collating evidence and being able to meet with the assessor(s).
